

EU REACH Statement

In June 2007, the European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) was first released. This Regulation establishes specific duties and obligations for companies in the European Union (EU) that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations, or in articles.

Under the structure of the REACH Regulation, Intersoft Electronics NV is a manufacturer and supplier of “articles”. We do not manufacture or supply “substances” or “preparations” and our articles do not involve the “intentional release of substances”. Accordingly, we foresee no registration or pre-registration requirement for the products we supply.

Intersoft Electronics NV is constantly monitoring the substances of very high concern (SVHCs), as defined by REACH, in our products. Having evaluated supplier certifications and material composition declarations, Intersoft Electronics NV has, to the best of its knowledge and belief, determined that none of the substances of very high concern (SVHC), as published on 8 July 2021, are present in our products and packaging in quantities totaling in a concentration equal or above 0.1% w/w. The European Chemical Agency (ECHA) regularly revises the SVHC candidate list, the latest version is available at <https://echa.europa.eu/en/candidate-list-table>.

With regards to the requirement of Article 67 of REACH: A substance on its own, in a preparation or in an article, for which Annex XVII of REACH contains restrictions, shall not be manufactured, placed on the market or used unless it complies with the conditions of that restriction.
